4. Monoculturalism: In some European states, culture is very closely linked to nationalism, thus government policy is to assimilate sub-groups.
5. Core Culture: The idea is that minorities can have an identity of their own, but they should at least support the core concepts of the culture on which the society is based.
6. Christianity is not, nor was it ever, meant to be a "sub-culture," it is our Core Culture.
